1 - INCORPORATION AND PURPOSE

Greyhaven Exotic Bird Sanctuary (The "Society") was incorporated under the Provisions of the Society Act of Vritish Columbia in 1998 with the objective of protecting and enhancing the quality of life of exotic birds.
